 3 “(2) ELIGIBLE TECHNOLOGY.—The term ‘eligi-
 4 ble technology’ means modern computer, and com-
 5 munication technology software, services, or tools,
 6 including computer or mobile devices, whether for
 7 use in school or at home, software applications, sys-
 8 tems and platforms, digital learning content, and re-
 9 lated services, supports, and strategies, which may
 10 include strategies to assist eligible children without

1 adequate Internet access at home to complete home-
2 work.

3 “(3) TECHNOLOGY READINESS SURVEY.—The
4 term ‘technology readiness survey’ means a survey
5 completed by a local educational agency that pro-
6 vides standardized information on the quantity and
7 types of technology infrastructure and access avail-
8 able to the students and in the community served by
9 the local educational agency, including computer de-
10 vices, access to school libraries, Internet connectivity
11 (including Internet access outside of the school day),
12 operating systems, related network infrastructure,
13 data systems, educator professional learning needs
14 and priorities, and data security.

15 “(4) UNIVERSAL DESIGN FOR LEARNING.—The
16 term ‘universal design for learning’ has the meaning
17 given the term in section 103 of the Higher Edu-
18 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1003).

19 **“SEC. 5702A. RESTRICTION.**

20 “Funds awarded under this part shall not be used
21 to address the networking needs of an entity that is eligi-
22 ble to receive support under the E-rate program.
